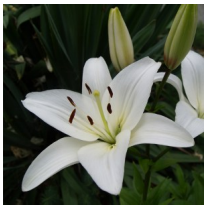

Description

Description for Asiatic Lily (White)

Lilium asiaticum is the scientific name of the plant. Bulbous rootstock with central growing point covered by concentric layers of scales. This perennial lily flowers are trumpet shaped, reflexed, cup shaped or bowl shaped. All lily flowers have six petals and six anthers. Most are sweetly scented. Stems are mid-sized to tall, and excellent for cutting.

Common name(s): Asiatic lily

Flower colours: White

Bloom time: Summer

Max reachahble height: Up to 39 inches

Difficulty to grow:: Easy to grow

Planting and care

Bulbs should be planted in winter/spring or fall ; 8 to 10 cm deep and 18 to 20 cm apart. Plant the bulbs with the flat end down, then mulch lightly to retain moisture.

Sunlight: Full sun or partial shade

Soil: Sandy or clay, well-drained

Water: Medium

Temperature: 14 to 25 degrees C

Fertilizer: Organic matter, such as aged compost or well-rotted manure

Caring for Asiatic Lily

- Remove old stems in late fall to help discourage diseases.
- Bulbs of this lily should never sit in soggy soil.
- Protect against frost.

Harvesting

You can cut the flowers in the summer.

Typical uses of Asiatic Lily

Special features: Flowers

Culinary use: NA

Ornamental use: This flower can put on a great show in the early summer border. Lilies are a good choice for tubs or mixed containers and excellent for cutting.
