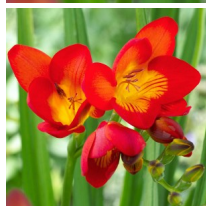

Description for Freesia (Red)

Freesias are a popular spring flowering bulb that produces bright and cheerful blooms with a delightful scent. A wide range of colors and an alluring floral fragrance make freesia hard to resist. With up to eight trumpet-shaped, upward-pointing blossoms on leafless stems, freesias make delightful cut flowers that last a long time in the vase.

Common name(s): Freesia

Flower colours: Red

Bloom time: Spring, Summer

Max reachable height: Up to 2 feet

Difficulty to grow:: Easy to grow

Planting and care

Freesia is propagated by a bulb. Best planting season of this bulb is in early in the spring. Use the potting mix for bulb plantation as Garden soil + Compost + Perlite + Sand (2:2:1:1)
Soil + Cocopeat + vermicompost (2:1:2)

Sunlight: Full to partial sunlight

Soil: Sandy loam soil

Water: Moderately

Temperature: 20 to 35 degrees C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Caring for Freesia

- Water a plant when the soil feels dry to touch. Water thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering for the winter & rainy season.
- Try to water the plants in the morning around 8-10am.
- You should remove dead, infected or damaged plant parts and throw in the garbage collector.
- You should fertilize a plant at planting time and growing season.

Typical uses of Freesia

Special features: Flower color

Ornamental use: This flowering plant is used as an ornamental plant.
