### Description for Nerine Lily (Random Color)

They are bulbous perennials. They produce spherical umbels of lily-like flowers in shades from white through pink to crimson. The leaves are threadlike and strap-shaped. Each flower is usually consisting of six narrow tepals.

**Common name(s):** Nerines, Guernsey lily, Jersey lily, spider lily

**Flower colours:** Any Color

**Bloom time:** Summer

**Max reachable height:** Up to 26 inches

**Difficulty to grow::** Easy to grow

## Planting and care

Planting season is in the spring or summer season. Dig a hole about three times as deep as the height of the bulb. Set the bulb in the hole, pointy end up, then cover with soil and press firmly. Space bulbs 8 to 10 inches apart. Water thoroughly after planting.

Use the potting mix for bulb plantation as  
Garden soil + Compost + Perlite + Sand (2:2:1:1)  
Soil + Cocopeat + vermicompost (2:1:2)

**Sunlight:** Full sun to partial sun

**Soil:** Sandy Soil, Loamy Soil, Well-drained soil

**Water:** Moderately

**Temperature:** 18 to 28 degrees C

**Fertilizer:** Use any organic fertilizer.

## Caring for Nerine Lily

- Water a plant when the soil feels dry to touch. Water thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering for the winter & rainy season.
- Try to water the plants in the morning around 8-10am.
- Avoid waterlogged soil.
- Reduce watering in the winter.
- You should remove dead, infected or damaged plant parts and throw in the garbage collector.
- You should fertilize a plant at planting time and growing season.
- Mulch the potting mix with organic material.

**Ornamental use:** They are used as cut flowers as they produce long-lasting blooms.
