Description for Dragon Fruit, Ajagar Phal (Grown through seeds)

Plant height: 5 - 9 inches (12 - 23 cm)

Plant spread: 3 - 5 inches (7 - 13 cm)

The dragon fruit is a member of the cactus family. Dragon fruit is the fruit of several different cactus species indigenous to the Americas. Dragon fruit usually refers to the fruit of the genus *Stenocereus* while dragon fruit refers to the fruit of the genus *Hylocereus* both in the family Cactaceae. Dragon fruit is cultivated in Southeast Asia, Florida in the United States, the Caribbean, Australia, and throughout tropical and subtropical regions of the world.

Common name(s): Dragon fruit, pitaya, pitahaya, Night-blooming Cereus, king of the night, Strawberry Pear, Belle of the Night, Cinderella Plant

Flower colours: White.

Bloom time: May to June

Max reachable height: up to 5 - 9 inches.

Difficulty to grow: Easy to grow.

Planting and care

Initial care for 1-2 weeks after receiving plant at your location:

- Keep the plant in natural indirect bright Light.
- Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
- Water when top soil (3-4 inches) feels dry to touch.
- Do not re-pot for min. 2 weeks after receiving it.

Key requirements to keep plant healthy:

Sunlight: Natural bright light.

Soil: Soil should be well drain and fertile, rich in organic content.

Water: Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture. Water when topsoil (3-4 inches) feels dry to touch. Water thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.

Temperature: 10 to 30 degrees C.

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer.

Caring for Dragon Fruit

Sunlight

- Keep the plant outdoor in natural bright light.
 - **Shade** the Dragon Fruit Plant from direct harsh sunlight as it can cause damage to the foliage.
 - **Watering** should be well drained and fertile rich in organic content.
 - Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
 - Water when top soil (3-4 inches) feels dry to touch.
 - **Application of Fertilizer** summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.
 - During the main growing season feed the plant with organic fertilizer once a month.
 - **Re-potting** topsoil without disturbing the roots of the plant so it can uptake the nutrients and moisture easily.
 - When a plant outgrows in current pot, re-pot with fresh potting soil and some fertilizer.
 - Do the re-potting late evening and keep the plant in shady area for 2 to 3 days and then move the plant in its suitable climatic zone.

Plant Protection

- Remove dead, infected or damaged plant parts and dispose them away from the planting area.
- Spray Neem, Eucalyptus or Citrus oil for any insect/pest attack, as a primary treatment.

Don'ts

- Do not over-water the plant especially when pot does not have drainage holes.

Harvesting

Once the color of the fruit has changed from green to yellow or red, then it is ready to harvest.
