Plant height: 28 - 44 inches (71 - 112 cm)

Plant spread:

Narrow Petal Frangipani is a cultivated hybrid derived from a cross between Plumeria stenophylla and an unknown parent. The tree grows

mostly up to around 1.5-2 m tall and is deciduous, therefore losing its leaves during long, dry periods.

Common name(s): Narrow Petal Frangipani, Narrow Petal Plumeria

Flower colours: white

Bloom time: September or October.

Max reachable height: 5m

Difficulty to grow: easy to grow

Planting and care

An accurate soil test will tell you where your pH currently stands. Acidic (sour) soil is counteracted by applying finely ground limestone, and alkaline (sweet) soil is treated with ground sulfur. If you order roses from a mail-order company, order early, in January or February (March at the latest). They are usually shipped in the spring as bare roots when plants are fully dormant, well before they have leafed out

Sunlight: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: 55F

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Caring for Gunnera

- Start with pruning shears for smaller growth. Use loppers, which look like giant, long-handle shears, for growth that is more than half an inch thick.
- A small pruning saw is handy, as it cuts on both the push and the pull.

Typical uses of Gunnera
