Planting and care

Also, select a site that gets full sun. For dependable blooms, lilies need six to eight hours of direct sunlight a day. If it's too shady, the stems will attempt to lean towards the sun or get spindly and fall over.

Sunlight: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: 13 to 24 C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Caring for Hemerocallis Fulva Kwanso

- Day lilies will grow in full sun in the North and will tolerate the same in the South with sufficient moisture.
- Plants grow well in partial shade, which is preferred for varieties with pastel flowers.
- Daylilies are drought-tolerant once established, but perform best with consistent moisture.

Typical uses of Hemerocallis Fulva Kwanso

Special features: The flowers of some species are edible and are used in Chinese cuisine. They are sold (fresh or dried) in Asian markets as gum jum or golden needles or yellow flower

Ornamental use: The plant is used for ornamental purpose.
