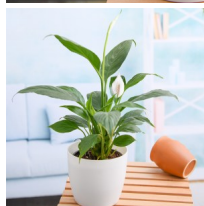


Peace Lily, Spathiphyllum - Plant

Description for Peace Lily, Spathiphyllum

Plant height: 6 - 10 inches (15 - 26 cm)

Plant spread: 4 - 6 inches (10 - 16 cm)

Common name(s): Peace lily, Cobra plant.

Flower colours: Creamy-White.

Bloom time: Spring or early summer.

Max reachable height: Up to 40 Centimeters

Difficulty to grow: Easy.

Planting and care

Initial care for 1-2 weeks after receiving plant at your location:

Keep the plant in Natural indirect bright light / Artificial bright Light.

Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.

apply 3 cup (Approx. 150 ml) water when top soil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch.

Do not re-pot for min. 2 weeks after receiving it.

Key requirements to keep plant healthy:

Sunlight: Natural indirect /artificial bright light.

Soil: Soil should be well drain and fertile, rich in organic content.

Water: Apply 3 cup (Approx. 150 ml) water when the topsoil (1-2 inch) in pot feels dry to touch.

Temperature: 18 to 24 degree Celsius

Fertilizer: Apply organic fertilizer once a month.

Caring for Peace Lily

Sunlight

- **Sunlight** Natural indirect / artificial bright light is ideal for peace lily plant growth.
- **Watering** should be well drained and fertile, rich in organic content.
- Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
- Apply 1 cup (Approx. 50 ml) water when the top soil (1-2 inch) in pot feels dry to touch.
- Apply water probably in the morning or evening time.
- Do not overwater the plant.
- **Application of Fertilizer** the plant thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.
- Before application of fertilizer loosen the topsoil without disturbing the roots of the plant so it can uptake the nutrients and moisture.
- During the main growing season (Feb to May, July to Sept.) feed the plant with organic fertilizer once a month.
- **Pest Protection** immediately after application of fertilizer.
- Remove dead, infected or damaged plant parts and discard them away from the plants.
- For any insect attack or disease, you can use Neem oil, Eucalyptus oil or Citrus oil spray for primary treatment.

Don'ts

- Do not over water the plant especially when pot does not have drainage holes.
- keep away from the AC Vents.

Typical uses of Peace Lily

Special features: One of the rare indoor flowering plant and excellent air purifying plant.

Ornamental use:

It makes an excellent container or house plant.
