**Plant height:** 9 - 15 inches (22 - 39 cm)

**Plant spread:** 4 - 6 inches (10 - 16 cm)

Winter hardy to USDA Zones 9-11. In St. Louis, plants should be grown in the ground as annuals or in pots/containers that may be overwintered indoors. Plants need well-drained soils in full sun.

## Planting and care

*Tecoma capensis*, commonly known as cape honeysuckle, is a flowering, versatile evergreen that is suitable as a climbing vine, border plant, shrub or ground cover. It blooms in clusters of tubular, red-orange flowers that are about 2 inches in length in the late summer, fall and winter.

**Sunlight:** Full sun

**Soil:** well-drained soil

**Water:** Medium

**Temperature:** 28Â°F

**Fertilizer:** Apply any organic fertilizer

## Caring for Tecoma

- Train a climbing vine cape honeysuckle plant on a trellis or other supporting object using plant ties to support the vines. .
- To maintain the shape of shrubs, prune long or unruly branches back to a side branch or bud with sharp pruning shears.

## Typical uses of Tecoma

**Special features:** For the St. Louis area, grow in containers as patio plants that are overwintered indoors. In southern Florida and California, this may be planted as a specimen or massed in gardens and shrub borders or grown in containers.
