Description for Yellow Lily, Hybrid Lotus (Yellow)

Plant height: 19 - 29 inches (48 - 74 cm)

Plant spread:

Nymphaea mexicana is aquatic rhizomatous perennial herb, sometimes with stolons, as well. The leaves grow from the rhizome on long petioles. Most of them float on the surface of the water.

Flowers are floating or emersed, 6-11 cm in diameter, opening and closing diurnally, only sepals and outermost petals in distinct whorls of 4.

Best grown in moist, acidic, humusy soils in part shade to full shade. Plants may be grown from seed, but will not flower for 4-5 years. Quicker and better results are obtained from planting corms which are sold by many bulb suppliers and nurseries. In addition, offsets from mature plants may be harvested and planted.

Common name(s): Yellow Lily, Hybrid Lotus, Waterlily, Mexican waterlily and banana waterlily.

Flower colours: Yellow

Bloom time: April

Max reachable height: 0.25 to 0.50 feet

Difficulty to grow: Easy to grow

Planting and care

Plant lily bulbs in autumn. Note: Lilies do not thrive in Zones 9 to 10 without a period of refrigeration; they need a cold, dormant period. Select a site with soil that drains well. How can you tell? After a good rain, find a spot that is the first to dry out. Water trapped beneath the scales may rot the bulb, so a well-drained site is essential.

Sunlight: Part shade to full shade

Soil: Clay

Water: Medium

Temperature: 70 degrees to 90 degrees F

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Caring for Yellow Lily

- In active growth, water freely especially if rainfall is less than 1 inch per week.
- Keep lilies mulched so that their roots are cool. The mulch should feel moist but not wet.
- Apply a high-potassium liquid fertilizer every 2 weeks from early spring until 6 weeks after flowering.
- Keep moist in winter.

Typical uses of Yellow Lily

Special features: Naturalize in moist soils in shaded areas of native plant gardens, shade gardens, woodland gardens or wild/naturalized areas. Also grows well in pond or stream banks or in shady areas of rock gardens.
