Description for Dieffenbachia Amoena Tropic Snow

Plant height: 9 - 15 inches (22 - 39 cm)

Plant spread: 4 - 8 inches (10 - 21 cm)

Dieffenbachia belonged to family Araceae. Dieffenbachia is a herbaceous plant with straight stem, simple and alternate leaves containing white spots and flecks, making it attractive as indoor foliage. Dieffenbachia is a broad-leaved foliage plant with thick succulent stems. The large and showy dieffenbachia can be the perfect living decoration for the home or office. When you learn how to care for a dieffenbachia plant, you will find it to be adaptable to different kinds of lighting and conditions.

Common name(s): Dumb cane, leopard lily, mother-in-law's tongue.

Flower colours: White.

Bloom time: Rarely bloom.

Max reachable height: Up to 1.5 meters.

Difficulty to grow: Easy to grow.

Planting and care

Initial care for 1-2 weeks after receiving plant at your location:

Keep the plant in natural indirect bright Light.

Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.

Water when top soil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch.

Do not re-pot for min. 2 weeks after receiving it.

Key requirements to keep plant healthy:

Sunlight: Indirect bright light or artificial bright light.

Soil: Soil should be well drain and fertile, rich in organic content.

Water: Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture. Water when topsoil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch. Water thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.

Temperature: 18 to 23 degrees Celsius.

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer.

Caring for Dieffenbachia Amoena Tropic Snow

Sunlight

- Keep the plant in indoor indirect bright light or artificial bright light.
- **Soil** protect the plant from direct harsh sunlight as it can cause damage to the foliage.
- **Watering** should be well drained and fertile rich in organic content.
- Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
- Water when top soil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch.
- **Apply** **thoroughly** fertilizes summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.
- During the main growing season feed the plant with organic fertilizer once a month.
- **Re-potting** topsoil without disturbing the roots of the plant so it can uptake the nutrients and moisture easily.
- When a plant outgrows in current pot, re-pot with fresh potting soil and some fertilizer.
- **For the re-potting procedure** [click here](#) keep the plant in shady area for 2 to 3 days and then move the plant in its suitable climatic condition.

Plant Protection

- Remove dead, infected or damaged plant parts and dispose them away from the planting area.
- Spray Neem, Eucalyptus or Citrus oil for any insect/pest attack, as a primary treatment.

Don'ts

- Easily grows in AC rooms but away from AC vents.
- Do not over-water the plant especially when pot does not have drainage holes.
