### Description for Dracaena Massangeana, Dracaena fragrans

**Plant height:** 11 - 18 inches (27 - 46 cm)

**Plant spread:** 6 - 10 inches (15 - 26 cm)

It is a popular ornamental houseplant grown both indoor and outdoor in the subtropical climate. It has a stalky stem with long green leaves with light yellow strips running through the stem. It is easy to grow plant that requires little maintenance.

It is a stunning houseplant with wide brightly marked leaves and thick woody stem. It does well in low light condition and its wide leaves are long and arc gracefully from the stalk.

**Common name(s):** Cane plant, Cane corn plant, Canestalk dracaena, Happy plant, Chinese money plant

## Planting and care

### Initial care for 1-2 weeks after receiving plant at your location:

Allow your plants to settle to your location first after receiving it.

Do not overwater them suddenly.

Check the moisture in the soil. If it is too dry then apply water gently.

Keep the plant in indirect bright light. Gradually move it to more bright location.

Do not re-pot immediately after receiving it.

### Key requirements to keep plant healthy:

**Sunlight:** Full to partial shade

**Soil:** Well drained soil

**Water:** Moderately

**Temperature:** 20-30 degree Celsius

**Fertilizer:** Apply any organic fertilizer.

## Caring for Dracaena Massangeana

### Sunlight:

- This plant should be grown in bright indirect sunlight, but is known to tolerate lower light levels.

### Soil

- It require well-drained soil rich in organic matter.

### Watering

- Water only when the soil feels dry to touch.
- Soil must never be allowed to dry out completely.

### Application of Fertilizer

- Apply organic fertilizers during spring and rainy season.
- Loosen the soil without damaging the roots. It will help the plant to uptake the nutrients and moisture easily.

### Repotting

- When a plant outgrows in current pot, re-pot with fresh potting soil and some fertilizer.

- Do the re-potting late evening and keep the plant in shady area for 2 to 3 days and then move the plant in required light condition.

**Plant Protection**

- Wipe the dust from the leaves with a clean, damp cloth.
- Remove dead, decay and infected part of the plant.
- For insect attack apply neem oil or any organic insecticide.

## Typical uses of Dracaena Massangeana

**Special features:** NASA studies reveal that Dracaenas absorb carbon dioxide and release oxygen and also eliminate significant amounts of benzene, formaldehyde, and trichloroethylene.

**Ornamental use:** The plant is used for ornamental purpose.
