


Sedum adolphii Lime Gold, Golden Sedum - Succulent Plant

Description for Sedum adolphii Lime Gold, Golden Sedum

Plant height: 2 - 5 inches (5 - 13 cm)

Plant spread: 3 - 5 inches (7 - 13 cm)

It is tender succulent plant upto a height of 8 inches. The leaves are lime green with red-orange flushed tips as they mature. They are more golden in the sun. It blooms in spring with small, star-shaped, yellow-white flower heads produced at the tips.

Common name(s): Golden sedum

Flower colours: white-yellow

Bloom time: Spring

Max reachable height: 8 inches

Difficulty to grow: Easy to grow.

Planting and care

Sunlight: Full sun to partial shade.

Soil: Well drained soil.

Water: Moderately

Temperature: 20-26 degrees C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer in spring.

Caring for Sedum adolphii Lime Gold

- Once established, sedum plants require little care. Check your plants regularly to make sure they are not too dry and water when needed.
- After flowering, cut back the plants to maintain their shape or contain them in one area.
- Remember to divide your plants in the spring or fall to control their spread.
