Description for Mandevilla (White)

Plant height: 9 - 15 inches (22 - 39 cm)

Plant spread: 4 - 6 inches (10 - 16 cm)

Mandevilla is a genus of tropical and subtropical flowering vines belonging to the family Apocynaceae. It produces Large trumpet-shaped white flowers. It is able to develop long, woody stems based on lignin and climbs by twining around some support.

Common name(s): Mandevilla, rocktrumpet, Dipladenia, Brazilian jasmine.

Flower colours: -

Bloom time: Heaviest in summer and sporadically throughout the rest of the year

Max reachable height: 3 to 10 feet

Difficulty to grow: Moderate to grow

Planting and care

Keep the plant in natural indirect bright Light.
Check the moisture in the soil before watering it.
Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
Water when top soil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch.
Do not re-pot for min. 2 weeks after receiving it.

Sunlight:

At least 3-6 hours of preferably morning sunlight a day is ideal for plant to grow well and natural indirect bright light for the rest of the day.

Soil:

The soil should be well drained and fertile, rich in organic content for growing plant.

Water:

Before water poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
Water when top soil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch.
Water thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.

Temperature: 55 degrees F/13 degrees C

Fertilizer:

During the main growing season (June-July) feed the plant with organic fertilizer.

Caring for Mandevilla

Once indoors, place your mandevilla vine in a place where it will get bright, indirect light. Water the plant when the soil is dry to the touch. In the spring, when the temperatures are consistently above 50 F. (10 C.), remove any dead leaves and move your mandevilla plant back outside to enjoy for another summer.
