### Description for *Nephrolepis exaltata bosteniensis*, Boston Fern

**Plant height:** 5 - 8 inches (12 - 21 cm)

**Plant spread:**

*Nephrolepis exaltata*, known as the sword fern or Boston fern, is a species of fern in the family Lomariopsidaceae. The Boston fern is one of the most well-known ferns and admired for its desirable traits as a houseplant. Boston ferns are typically attractive, with long, graceful fronds bedecked with tiny leaves. It is a relatively tough fern, with a higher tolerance for light than other species, and as far as ferns go, they are more tolerant of dry conditions and easy to propagate.

**Common name(s):** Sword fern, Boston fern, Boston swordfern, Wild Boston fern, Boston Fern, Boston Blue Bell Fern, Tuber ladder fern, and Fishbone fern

**Bloom time:** Non-flowering

## Planting and care

### Initial care for 1-2 weeks after receiving plant at your location:

Keep the plant in Natural indirect bright Light.

Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.

apply 4 cup (Approx. 200 ml) water when top soil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch.

Do not re-pot for min. 2 weeks after receiving it.

### Key requirements to keep plant healthy:

**Sunlight:** Natural indirect /artificial bright light.

**Soil:** Soil should be well-drained and fertile, rich in organic content.

**Water:** Apply 4 cup (Approx. 200 ml) water when the topsoil (1-2 inch) in pot feels dry to touch.

**Temperature:** 15 to 27 degrees Celsius

**Fertilizer:** Apply organic fertilizer once a month.

## Caring for *Nephrolepis exaltata bosteniensis*

### Sunlight

- ~~Soil~~ Keep the plant in Natural indirect/Artificial bright light area.
- ~~Watering~~ Soil should be well drained and fertile, rich in organic content.
- Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
- Apply 4 cup (Approx. 200 ml) water when the top soil (1-2 inch) in pot feels dry to touch.
- Apply water probably in the morning or evening time.
- Do not overwater the plant.
- ~~Application of Fertilizer~~ Apply fertilizer the plant thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.
- Before the application of fertilizer loosen the topsoil without disturbing the roots of the plant so it can uptake the nutrients and moisture.
- During the main growing season feed the plant with organic fertilizer once a month.
- ~~Apply Protection~~ Apply Protection immediately after application of fertilizer.
- Remove dead, infected or damaged plant parts and discard them away from the plants.
- For any insect attack or disease, you can use Neem oil, Eucalyptus oil or Citrus oil spray for primary treatment.

### Don'ts

- Do not over water the plant especially when pot does not have drainage holes.
- Do not expose plant to direct sunlight.

## Typical uses of *Nephrolepis exaltata bosteniensis*

**Special features:** The NASA Clean Air Study determined that this plant was effective at removing common household air toxins formaldehyde and xylene.

**Ornamental use:** It can also be grown on hanging basket.
