Description for Nimboo, Lemon (Seedless, Grafted)

Plant height: 48 - 72 inches (121 - 183 cm)

Plant spread: 5 - 9 inches (12 - 23 cm)

Lemon is perennial evergreen fruiting tree in Rutaceae family. The tree has a spreading, upright growth habit, few large branches and stiff thorns. The tree possesses large, oblong or oval, light green leaves and produces purple-white flowers in clusters. The lemon fruit is an ellipsoid berry surrounded by a green rind, which ripens to yellow, protecting the soft yellow segmented pulp.

Common name(s): Kagzi lime, Nimboo, lemon

Flower colours: White

Bloom time: Early spring & Late winter

Max reachable height: Maximum 6 to 10 ft

Difficulty to grow: Easy to moderate

Planting and care

Keep the plant in natural indirect bright Light.
Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
Water when top soil (1-2inches) feels dry to touch.
Do not re-pot for min. 2 weeks after receiving it.

Sunlight:

More than 6 hours of direct bright sunlight a day.

Soil:

The soil should be well drained and fertile, rich in organic content for growing plant.

Water:

Before water poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
Water when top soil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch.
Water thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.

Temperature: 13 to 37 degrees C

Fertilizer:

During the main growing season (June-July) feed the plant with organic fertilizer.

Caring for Nimboo

- For planting in a container select a large pot with a minimum size of 18'' or above.
- Use well-drained soil for plantation. We recommended to you pinch off all the flower buds in the first year and let the plant grow.
- Daily watering is required for this plant.

Harvesting

Harvest when fruits are mature on a tree.
