Description for Barleria Repens, Tambadi Korant, Barleria (Peach)

Plant height: 9 - 15 inches (22 - 39 cm)

Plant spread:

The plant will grow as its surrounds allow, ranging from about a metre high in exposed conditions to two metres in shady, sheltered conditions. The leaves are soft, covered in a light hair, with a slightly blue hue to their green.

Common name(s): Bush Violet

Flower colours: Purple or a pretty pink-red.

Bloom time: April and May.

Max reachable height: They usually only reach heights of up to a metre, but can get larger if they are climbing up a tree.

Difficulty to grow: Easy.

Planting and care

Sunlight: Full sun to partial shade.

Soil: Barleria obtusa grows in a wide variety of soils. To ensure good drainage, add compost and mulch well to retain water.

Water: Regular watering when possible will result in a spectacular show of colour.

Temperature: They tolerate temperatures only above at least 1C.

Fertilizer: Organic fertilizer pellets and a handful of rich compost to each hollow.

Caring for Barleria Repens

Nip off the growing tips during spring and the early part of summer to increase bushiness and flowers. After the shrub has flowered, cut back hard, then prune or tip periodically to ensure neat, compact growth.

Typical uses of Barleria Repens

Special features:

Ornamental use: The shrublet can be planted in mixed borders and banks.
