Description Plerandra elegantissima also known as false aralia is a species of flowering plant in the Araliaceae family, native to New Caledonia. Growing to 8â€"15 m tall by 2 m broad, it is an evergreen shrub or tree.

Common name: false aralia

Color: Yellow-green

Bloom time: Rarely flowers indoors

Height: 25.00 to 50.00 feet

Difficulty level: easy to grow

Planting & Care

The foliage suffers damage when temperatures fall below 60 degrees F. (15 C.). Care for false aralia plants includes regular watering and fertilizing. Water the plant when the soil is dry at a depth of one inch. Drench the pot with water and empty the saucer under the pot after the excess drains through.

Sunlight: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: 65-85Â°F

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Site.
- Bright indirect light.
- Temperature.

- Average warmth.
- Water.
- Quite regularly in the growing season but do not let the compost stay soggy (or dry out completely).
- Mist as often as possible.
- Feeding.
- A liquid feed every month or so.

Special Feature:

Low-maintenance indoor potted plant.
