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Description Tabernaemontana is a genus of flowering plants in the family Apocynaceae. It has a pan-tropical distribution, found in Asia, Africa, Australia, North America, South America, and a wide assortment of oceanic islands.

Planting & Care

Crepe jasmines thrive outdoors in warm climates like those found in USDA plant hardiness zones 9 through 11. Although the shrubs look elegant and refined, they are not at all picky about soil as long as it is well drained.

Sunlight: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temprature: 50 degrees F.

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Crepe jasmine care is reduced if you are growing the plant in acidic soil.
- With slightly alkaline soil, youâ€™ll need to apply fertilizer regularly to prevent the shrub from getting chlorosis.
- If the soil is very alkaline, crepe jasmine care will include more frequent applications of fertilizer.
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Special Feature:

An easy-to-grow plant which is best massed in informal settings such as native plant gardens, shade gardens or open woodland areas. Also appropriate for borders or containers.

Use

Medicinal use:

- This plant is used in Ayurveda.

Ornamental use:

- The plant is used for ornamental purpose.
