Plant height: 15 - 23 inches (38 - 59 cm)

Plant spread: 3 - 5 inches (7 - 13 cm)

Hibiscus is a genus of flowering plants in the mallow family Malvaceae. It is quite large containing several hundred species that are native to warm-temperate subtropical and tropical regions throughout the world.

Hibiscus is deciduous herbaceous plants with dark green alternate ovate leaves. The yellow flowers are large, conspicuous, trumpet-shaped, with five or more petals yellow color.

## Planting and care

## Initial care for 1-2 weeks after receiving plant at your location:

- Keep the plant in Natural direct bright Light.
- Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
- Water when top soil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch.
- Do not re-pot for min. 2 weeks after receiving it.

Key requirements to keep plant healthy:

Sunlight: Natural bright light.

Soil: Soil should be well drain and fertile, rich in organic content.

#### Water:

- Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture. Water when topsoil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch.
- Water thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.

Temperature: 16 to 32 Degrees Celsius.

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer.

#### **Caring for Hibiscus**

#### Sunlight

- Soleast five to six hours of sunlight a day is ideal for flowering and plant grow well in natural bright light .
- Stateringd be well drain and fertile, rich in organic content.
- Water the plant when the top soil (1-2 inch) in pot feels dry to touch.
- Do not overwater the plant.
- Applicationugh Fert illizes ummer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.
- During the main growing season feed the plant with organic fertilizer once a month.
- · Planse Protectips oil without disturbing the roots of the plant so it can uptake the nutrients and moisture easily.
- $\circ\,$  Remove dead, infected or damaged plant parts and discard them away from the plants.
- For any insect attack or disease, you can use Neem oil, Eucalyptus oil or Citrus oil spray for primary treatment.
  Don'ts
- o Do not over water the plant.
- · Avoid applying water on flowers and leaves it may cause fungus infection.
