Description for Kalanchoe daigremontiana

Plant height: 2 - 5 inches (5 - 13 cm)

Plant spread: 3 - 5 inches (7 - 13 cm)

This Kalanchoe is an upright perennial succulent up to 3 feet in height, with opposite, fleshy oblong-lanceolate, grey-green leaves, brown-red leaf margin, and with a row of plantlets on each edge. The plantlets form roots while on the plant. The flowers are tubular, grayish pink in color, up to 1 inch long.

Common name(s): Mexican Hat Plant, Mother of Thousands, Alligator Plant, Devils Backbone

Flower colours: Pink

Bloom time: Not defined

Max reachable height: Up to 3 feet

Difficulty to grow: Easy to grow

Planting and care

Kalanchoe will produce tiny plantlets along the leaf margins that can be individually potted up.

Re-pot with the following proportions: 3 parts of potting soil, 1 part of grit (pumice), 1 part of the horticultural-grade sand, 1/2 part of the compost etc.

Sunlight: Full sun, partial sun, at least 4 to 6 hours of sunlight per day.

Soil: Avoid excess organic contents in the soil.

Water: Low for the rainy season, Moderate for winter, More than moderate for a summer

Temperature: Ideal: 22 to 35 degrees C

Fertilizer: No need much. A peat-based compost should not be used.

Caring for Kalanchoe daigremontiana

- Keep in a bright sunny location.
- Try not to water the leaves, give water to soil only.
- Avoid overwatering as the roots may get rot.
- Water the plant in a morning, between 8 to 10 am.
- Avoid keeping in suffocated areas or in dark room.
- While, re-potting or propagating try not to disturb the roots.

Typical uses of Kalanchoe daigremontiana

Special features: Survivals and growers of the summer.

Ornamental use: Kalanchoe daigremontiana is used as the ornamental plant.
