Mandevilla is a genus of tropical and subtropical flowering vines belonging to the family Apocynaceae. Its beautiful showy bright pink blossoms and shiny green leaves brighten up your garden outdoors or sunny spots. Mandevilla develops spectacular, often fragrant flowers in warm climates. The flowers come in a variety of colors, including white, pink, yellow, and red which are attractive to hummingbirds and butterflies.

Common name(s): Dipladenia, Brazilian jasmine, Mandevilla.

Flower colours: Pink color.

Bloom time: Summer.

Max reachable height: up to 6 meters.

Difficulty to grow: Easy to Grow.

Planting and care

Initial care for 1-2 weeks after receiving plant at your location:

- Check the moisture in the soil before watering it.
- Water when the topsoil (1-2 inch) feels dry to touch.
- Keep the plant in direct bright light.
- Do not re-pot for min. 2 weeks after receiving it.

Key requirements to keep plant healthy:

Sunlight: bright direct natural light.

Soil: Well draining and nutrient-rich.

Water: Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture. Water when topsoil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch. Water thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.

Temperature: 25-40 degrees Celcius.

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer.
