Planting and care

Apple plantation is done from June to December. Normally, this plant is planted at a spacing of 4 x 4 m into pits of 60 cm x 60 cm x 60 cm. At the time of planting, mix organic manure in the soil.

Also, you can plant in the planter using the potting mix as the soil, vermicompost, and coco peat (1:1:1).

Sunlight: Full sunlight

Soil: Sandy loam well-drained soil

Water: Moderately

Temperature: 15 to 25 degree C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer.

Caring for Apple

- Use a balanced fertilizer every three months until the tree begins to bear fruit, and apply nitrogen annually once the tree is mature.
- Watering is done early in the morning if the soil is dry until the plants get established.
- Prune the plant after harvesting the fruits.

Typical uses of Apple

Special features: Apple fruits are delicious taste and excellent flavour.

Culinary use: Apples are an important ingredient in many desserts, such as apple pie, apple crumble, apple crisp and apple cake.

Ornamental use: Apple is used for the ornamental purpose.
