### Description for Shahtoot, Mulberry, Tuti ( Big Leaves )

**Plant height:** 15 - 23 inches (38 - 59 cm)

**Plant spread:** 3 - 5 inches (7 - 13 cm)

Mulberry is perennial plant in Moraceae family. The color of the bark is varies from green to brown. The leaves are simple, alternate, stipulate and petiolate. In mulberry inflorescence is a catkin more than ten flowers grow around rachis being attached to the axial of new shoots.

**Common name(s):** Shahtoot, Mulberry, Tuti

**Flower colours:** White

**Bloom time:** Early autumn or May

**Max reachable height:** Up to 10 m

**Difficulty to grow:** Easy to grow

## Planting and care

Keep the plant in natural indirect bright Light.  
Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.  
Water when top soil (1-2inches) feels dry to touch.  
Do not re-pot for min. 2 weeks after receiving it.

### Sunlight:

More than 6 hours of direct bright sunlight a day.

### Soil:

The soil should be well drained and fertile, rich in organic content for growing plant.  
Grow well in pH range of 6.5 to 7

### Water:

Before water poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.  
Water when top soil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch.  
Water thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.

**Temperature:** 20 to 28 degrees C

### Fertilizer:

During the main growing season (June-July) feed the plant with organic fertilizer.

## Caring for Shahtoot

- Staking mulberry trees in the early years will prevent windrock, leading to good root development.
- Shahtoot responds to applied water and nutrients.
- Shahtoot can be pruned during winter dormancy or rainy season.

## Harvesting

Late spring and summer

## Typical uses of Shahtoot

**Special features:** Its leaves are used as food for silkworms.

**Culinary use:** Mulberries are also made into pies, tarts, jellies, syrups, marmalade, juice and wine. They can be dried and used as a snack, or in puddings or oatmeal cookies and muffins. Note- Please consults your health advisor before application or consuming of plants or plant parts.

**Ornamental use:** It can be used as a foliage plant.

**Medicinal use:** This plant is used in many pharmaceutical preparations. Note- Please consult your health advisor before application or consuming of plants or plant parts.
