Description for Origanum Majorana, Marjoram, Marwa

Plant height: 0.7 - 1.2 inches (1 - 4 cm)

Plant spread: 4 - 6 inches (10 - 16 cm)

Origanum Majorana has thin, gray-green leaves and in early summer, small, white to pink flowers appear along the stem. The flavor of the leaves are similar to oregano, but sweeter. Sweet Marjoram (*Origanum majorana*) is easy to grow herb well suited for growing in containers as well as the garden. Marjoram plants are tender perennials, freezing temperatures will cause serious injury or death to the plants.

Common name(s): Marjoram

Flower colours: White-Pink

Bloom time: Jan-April

Max reachable height: Up to 60 centimeter

Difficulty to grow: Easy

Planting and care

Initial care for 1-2 weeks after receiving plant at your location:

- Keep the plant in Natural indirect bright Light.
- Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
- Apply 3 cup (Approx. 150 ml) water when top soil (1-2 inches) in pot feels dry to touch.
- Do not re-pot for min. 2 weeks after receiving it.

Key requirements to keep plant healthy:

Sunlight: More than 6 hours of sunlight a day is ideal for plant to grow well and natural direct bright light for the rest of the day.

Soil: Soil should be well drain and fertile, rich in organic content

Water: Apply 3 cup (Approx. 150 ml) water when top soil (1-2 inches) in pot feels dry to touch.

Temperature: 20 to 30 degree Celsius

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer once a month (Oct-Jan).

Light Requirement

- **Soil** More than 6 hours of sunlight a day is ideal for plant to grow well and natural direct bright light for the rest of the day.
- **Watering** should be well drained and fertile, rich in organic content for growing plant.
- Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
- Apply 3 cup (Approx. 150 ml) water when top soil (1-2 inches) in pot feels dry to touch.
- As rule of thumb, Water the plant thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.
- Do not over-water the plant.

Application of Fertilizer

- Apply fertilizer in morning or evening.
- Loosen the topsoil without disturbing the roots of the plant so it can uptake the nutrients and moisture easily. .
- During the main growing season feed the plant with organic fertilizer once a month (Oct-Jan).
- Apply water immediately after application of fertilizer.

Re-potting

- When a plant outgrows in current pot, re-pot with fresh potting soil and some fertilizer.
- Do the re-potting late evening and keep the plant in shady area for 2 to 3 days and then move the plant in its suitable growing conditions.

Plant Protection

- Remove dead, infected or damaged plant parts and dispose them away from the planting area.
- Spray Neem, Eucalyptus or Citrus oil for any insect/pest attack, as a primary treatment.

Don'ts

- Do not over water the plant especially when pot does not have drainage holes.
- Avoid applying water on flowers and leaves it may cause fungus infection.

Typical uses of *Origanum Majorana*

Special features: Marwa leaves are used as fresh or dried and lend a spicy, sweet, almost piney flavour that compliments vegetables.

Culinary use: It is used for culinary purpose.

Ornamental use: It makes an excellent container or border plant.
