Red Neck Palm Plant

Description for Red Neck Palm

Plant height: 14 - 22 inches (35 - 56 cm)

Plant spread: 5 - 9 inches (12 - 23 cm)

It has a single, clean, white, waxy trunk ringed by the scars from the fallen fronds. The crown-shaft is covered in dense reddish-brown velvet like or fur-like fuzzy material tomentum, hence the name Teddy Bear Palm. The trunk has a lot of similarities with bamboo.

This is one of the more elegant and colorful *Dypsis*, and is now widespread in cultivation. With its large stature and fuzzy bright red crownshaft, it stands out in any setting. In the past *Dypsis lastelliana*, the "Redneck Palm," was often confused with *Dypsis leptochecilos*, the "Teddy Bear Palm." This confusion was engrained and still persists somewhat today.

Scientific name *Dypsis leptochecilos* or *Neodypsis lastelliana*, is a very elegant palm known for its unique trunk with a distinctive reddish-colored fuzzy crown-shaft.

Common name(s): *Dypsis lastelliana*, *Neodypsis lastelliana*, Teddy Bear Palm

Flower colours: Yellow

Bloom time: Spring, Summer, Fall

Max reachable height: 20-30 feet

Difficulty to grow: Easy to grow.

Planting and care

Sunlight: Part Sun, Filtered Shade, Morning sun

Soil: Soil with pH 5.6 to 6.0 (acidic), 6.1 to 6.5 (mildly acidic), 6.6 to 7.5 (neutral)

Water: Keep the soil moist

Temperature: It is cold hardy and can tolerate cold down upto 25 F and even withstand light frost for a short period of time when mature enough.

Fertilizer: To prevent nutritional deficiency, apply good quality palm fertilizer that has continues release formula twice a year during growing season.

Caring for Red Neck Palm

Grow teddy bear palm in full sun to light shade in moist, well-drained, non-alkaline soil. A sandy, humus-rich loam works well. It is most spectacular when grown in groups of three or five at staggered heights.
