Description for Piper Betel, Maghai Paan

Plant height: 6 - 10 inches (15 - 26 cm)

Plant spread: 4 - 8 inches (10 - 21 cm)

Piper betel is a Woody climber in Piperaceae family with adventitious roots at swollen nodes. Leaves are simple heart shaped, alternate with spicy taste. Inflorescence is axillary with white uni sexual flower.

Common name(s): Naagarvel, Vidyache paan

Flower colours: Dark red

Bloom time: Spring and early summer (anytime in tropics)

Max reachable height: 150 to 180 cm.

Difficulty to grow: Easy to grow

Planting and care

Keep the plant in natural indirect bright Light.

Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.

Water when top soil (1-2inches) feels dry to touch.

Do not re-pot for min. 2 weeks after receiving it.

Sunlight:

At least 3-6 hours of preferably morning sunlight a day is ideal for plant to grow well and natural indirect bright light for the rest of the day.

Soil:

The soil should be well drained and fertile, rich in organic content for growing plant.

Grow well in pH range of 6.5 to 7

Water:

Before water poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.

Water when top soil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch.

Water thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.

Temperature: 40 degrees Celsius.

Fertilizer:

During the main growing season (June-July) feed the plant with organic fertilizer.

Caring for Piper Betel

- Place your plant in a place that receives at least 5 to 6 hours of sunlight daily.
- It thrives well in a hot and humid environment in partial shade.
- The betel plant needs regular watering. Water only when the soil feels dry to touch.
- Loosen the soil without damaging the roots. It will help the plant to uptake the nutrients and moisture easily.
- Prune regularly after it reaches 2 m height to control the plant, regular pruning, and plucking of leaves encourages new growth and sweet and tender leaves.
- Occasional feeding every couple of months in the growing season of the plant with a nitrogen-rich organic fertilizer like manure or compost is recommended.

Harvesting

Within 4 to 6 months after planting, it will be ready for harvest. You can pick up its fresh aromatic leaves for various uses.

Typical uses of Piper Betel

Special features: It widely used as herb plant, ornamental foliage plant and medicinal plant.

Culinary use: Betel leaves are used for direct consumption.

Ornamental use: The plant is used to decorate the balcony, terrace or any outdoor space.

Medicinal use: It is used as a mild stimulant for its medicinal properties. Note- Please consult your health advisor before application or consuming of plants or plant parts.
