## Description for Thunbergia Erecta Alba, Meyenia Erecta Alba (White)

**Plant height:** 14 - 23 inches (35 - 59 cm)

**Plant spread:** 3 - 5 inches (7 - 13 cm)

It is best grown in organically rich, fertile, medium moisture, well-drained soils in full sun to part shade.

**Common name(s):** Thunbergia erecta, Acanthaceae, Acanthus, Meyenia erecta Mini, Meyenia White

**Flower colours:** White

**Bloom time:** August to September

**Max reachable height:** Up to 30 feet

## Planting and care

Both can survive in temperate climates if they are planted in a sheltered area. Arabian is a small bush with evergreen leaves. There are many other varieties of plant, of which are best suited for sub-tropical climates. Learning how to grow will add a striking visual and olfactory touch to the garden.

**Sunlight:** Full sunlight to partial shade

**Soil:** Well-drained soil

**Water:** Moderately

**Temperature:** 20 to 35 degrees F

**Fertilizer:** Apply any organic fertilizer

## Caring for Thunbergia Erecta Alba

- Grow the plants in full sun to light shade. In hotter regions, plant where they will receive afternoon shade.
- Grow Thunbergia in rich soils to help fuel growth. Prior to planting, mix in ample amounts of compost.
- Add a general purpose fertilizer every 4-6 weeks.
- Thunbergia plants do not tolerate droughts very well.
- Keep the soil well watered, especially when young, and during hot and dry weather. If grown in containers, be vigilant that they do not dry out.
- Thunbergia plants can be trimmed, as needed.
- Plants need the support of a fence, trellis or post. Train young plants to reach the support.

## Typical uses of Thunbergia Erecta Alba

**Special features:** Trellises, arbors, fences or other structures in areas where winter hardy. Hanging baskets and other containers when grown as an annual. Houseplant.

**Ornamental use:** The plant is used for ornamental purpose.
