Gomphrena is a warm-season annual plant.

Butterflies are attracted to flowers.

Gomphrena flower is used as a cut flower or dried flower.

Dried flower is simply hanging them upside down in a well-ventilated place, and you will have colour to enjoy all winter.

Common name(s): globe amaranth

Flower colours: White

Bloom time: June to frost

Max reachable height: 1.00 to 2.00 feet

Difficulty to grow: Easy to grow

Planting and care

Sow gomphrena seeds as an indoor plant to get a head start, or outdoors where you want the plants to grow at about the time of your last spring frost.

Sunlight: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: 70 F to 75 F.

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Caring for Gomphrena white

Water in very dry conditions.

Harvesting

June to frost

Typical uses of Gomphrena white

Special features: Borders, rock gardens, cutting gardens, annual beds or containers. Also useful as an edge.

Culinary use: NA

Ornamental use: The plant is used for ornamental purpose.

Medicinal use:

Plant is laxative, stomachic, carminative, astringent, depurative, emetic and good diuretic; found efficacious in renal dropsies and general anasarca.

Also used in coughs, pneumonia, rheumatism, piles, boils, skin eruptions, kidney stone and colic.
