There are many types of Pumpkins, that can grow in various types of climatic conditions. Pumpkins are heavy feeders. Regular treatments of manure or compost mixed with water will sustain good growth.

Common name(s): fluted gourd, fluted pumpkin, Ugu

Flower colours: Yellow

Bloom time: Summer, spring

Max reachable height: 1.5 to 15 ft

Difficulty to grow:: Easy to grow

Planting and care

Pumpkins do best when the seeds are directly planted in the ground.

Sunlight: Full sun

Soil: well-drained soil, fertile, loose soil, high in organic matter with pH between 5.8 and 6.8

Water: Moderately

Temperature: 20 to 30 degree C

Fertilizer: Use any organic fertilizer

Caring for Pumpkin desi

- Pumpkins are very thirsty plants and need lots of water. Water one inch per week. Water deeply, especially during fruit set.
- Pinch off the fuzzy ends of each vine after a few pumpkins have formed.
- Bees are essential for pollination, so be mindful when using insecticides to kill pests.

Special features: Pumpkins are cultivated in the very warm condition, which can also resist in cold temperature.

Culinary use:

Tender leaves and mature fruit are used for cooking purpose.

The cooked pulp is fabulous in pies, sweet preparation cookies, bread, soups, appetizers, main dishes . . . the list goes on and on!
