## Description for African Marigold (Yellow)

**Plant height:** 5 - 9 inches (12 - 23 cm)

**Plant spread:** 4 - 8 inches (10 - 21 cm)

African marigold botanically known as *Tagetes erecta* with upright growth habit with medium texture. In India marigold is one of the most commonly grown flowers and used extensively on religious and social functions in different forms. Flowers are sold in the market as loose or as garlands.

Indian cultures used as a medicinal herb as well as a dye for fabrics, foods and cosmetics. The petals added to dishes as a garnish.

They can be easily cultivated, are widely adaptable to varying soils and climatic conditions and have a good flowering duration. This

bushy plant with around 20 to 30 species have a long flowering period and the colors range from orange, yellow, gold, cream to apricot. They are very much used in making garlands. Make excellent beds and pot decorations.

**Common name(s):** African Marigold (Yellow), Zendu, Marigold, Genda, Zandu,

**Flower colours:** Yellow

**Bloom time:** Oct-Feb

**Max reachable height:** up to 60 to 90 centimeter

**Difficulty to grow:** Easy

## Planting and care

**Initial care for 1-2 weeks after receiving plant at your location:**

- Keep the plant in Natural indirect bright Light.
- Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
- Apply 3 cup (Approx. 150 ml ) water when top soil (1-2 inches) in pot feels dry to touch.
- Do not re-pot for min. 2 weeks after receiving it.

**Key requirements to keep plant healthy:**

**Sunlight:** Natural direct 3-6 hours of morning sunlight and natural direct bright light for the rest of the day.

**Soil:** Soil should be well drain and fertile, rich in organic content.

**Water:** Apply 3 cup (Approx. 150 ml ) water when top soil (1-2 inches) in pot feels dry to touch.

**Temperature:** 25 to 30 degree Celsius

**Fertilizer:** Apply any organic fertilizer once a month (Oct-Jan).

## Caring for African Marigold

### Light Requirement

- At least 3-6 hours of preferably morning sunlight a day is ideal for plant to grow well and natural direct bright light for the rest of the day.
- **Watering** should be well drained and fertile, rich in organic content for growing plant.
- Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
- Apply 3 cup (Approx. 150 ml) water when top soil (1-2 inches) in pot feels dry to touch.
- As rule of thumb, Water the plant thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.
- Do not over-water the plant.
- **Application of Fertilizer** morning or evening.
- Loosen the topsoil without disturbing the roots of the plant so it can uptake the nutrients and moisture easily. .
- During the main growing season feed the plant with organic fertilizer once a month (Oct-Jan).
- Apply water immediately after application of fertilizer.

### Re-potting

- When a plant outgrows in current pot, re-pot with fresh potting soil and some fertilizer.
- Do the re-potting late evening and keep the plant in shady area for 2 to 3 days and then move the plant in its suitable growing **For re-potting procedure [click here](#)**

### Plant Protection

- Remove dead, infected or damaged plant parts and dispose them away from the planting area.
- Spray Neem, Eucalyptus or Citrus oil for any insect/pest attack, as a primary treatment.

### Don'ts

- Do not over water the plant especially when pot does not have drainage holes.
- Avoid applying water on flowers and leaves it may cause fungus infection.

## Typical uses of African Marigold

**Special features:** Due to its dwarf height and colorful flower marigold is especially useful for decoration and included in landscape plans. Flowers are single to fully double and large sized with globular heads. Flower varies from lemon yellow to yellow, golden yellow or orange

**Culinary use:** The bright petals of signet marigolds add colour and a spicy tang to salads and other summer dishes. The flower petals are sometimes cooked with rice to impart the colour (but unfortunately not the flavour) of saffron.

**Ornamental use:** It is used as the edge plant or bed plant or in pot culture.

**Medicinal use:** One of the health benefits of marigolds is that it is used in the treatment of minor burns when used in the form of ointments or a tincture.
