Description for Lemon Grass

Plant height: 15 - 23 inches (38 - 59 cm)

Plant spread: 5 - 9 inches (12 - 23 cm)

Cymbopogon, better known as lemongrass is a genus of Asian, African, Australian, and tropical island plants in the grass family. Some species, are commonly cultivated as culinary and medicinal herbs because of their scent, resembling that of lemons.

This grass grows in dense clumps that can grow to 6 ft in height and about 4 ft in width, although it commonly has seen much smaller. Leaves are strap-like, 1.3 to 2.5 cm wide, to 3 ft long, and have gracefully drooping tips.

Common name(s): Lemon grass, barbed wire grass, silky heads, citronella grass, gavati chaha, oil grass

Flower colours: Yellow

Bloom time: Rarely flowers

Max reachable height: 2 to 4 feet

Although this plant is native to hot and humid areas in Southeast Asia, with proper care, lemongrass can be grown in almost any sunny garden.

Sunlight: Full sun

Temperature: 40 degrees F

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Caring for Lemon Grass

You can harvest your lemongrass anytime during the growing season. Choose stalks that are at least half an inch thick and cut them at ground level with a sharp, clean knife.

Special features: The stalk is used for cooking, and the leaves are used for teas. Lemongrass tea can be calming and soothing stomachs. A popular tea blend is Sleepy Time Tea, which is a mixture of lemongrass, lavender, and German chamomile flowers.
