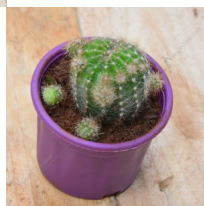
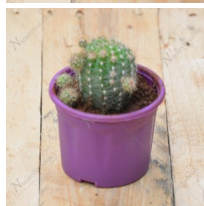


## Notocactus rutilans - Cactus Plant



*Parodia rutilans*, best known as *Notocactus rutilans*, is a small-growing, usually solitary, cactus species. The numerous stiff, sharp spines are varicoloured and the center is reddish-brown.

## Description for Notocactus rutilans

**Plant height:** 0.5 - 0.8 inches (1 - 3 cm)

**Plant spread:** 2 - 4 inches (5 - 11 cm)

Notocactus rutilans is a synonym of Parodia mueller-melchersii. The plants are very free-flowering and self-fertile; producing many seeds. When in flower the whole plant shimmers with colour and it flowers when quite young.

The dull green, elongated spherical shoots reach heights of up to 8 centimetres and diameter of 6 centimetres. The areoles on them are white. The light golden yellow to lemon yellow to reddish flowers.

The flowers are very showy, 5 cm long, with much white wool along the tubes, and translucent petals, salmon to carmine-red shading to egg-yolk yellow in the centre.

**Common name(s):** Pink ball cactus

**Flower colours:** Light golden yellow to lemon yellow to reddish

**Bloom time:** Mid Spring, Late Spring/Early Summer

**Max reachable height:** Up to 50 cm

**Difficulty to grow:** Easy to grow

## Planting and care

Grow well in moderate-humid climate.

**Sunlight:** It likes a warm bright location, does great in partial shade but doesn't like full, hot blazing sun in the central summer month.

**Soil:** It prefers a neutral to slightly acidic mineral-based potting mix with plenty of extra grit and feeds it during the summer.

**Water:** Water during the growing season but pot plants in winter are wet-sensitive and needs to be kept dry (rots easily if a soil is wet and cold)

tends to lose its roots in winter. Water Best if watered with rainwater.

**Temperature:** Ideal temperature 13 to 55.4 degrees F  
Minimum temperature in winter 10 to 50 degrees F

**Fertilizer:** Use any organic fertilizer.

## Caring for Notocactus rutilans

- Do not over water.
- Avoid complete shade.
