Description for Chlorophytum, Spider Plant

Plant height: 5 - 9 inches (12 - 23 cm)

Plant spread: 4 - 8 inches (10 - 21 cm)

The spider plant is considered one of the most adaptable of houseplants and the easiest to grow. The spider plant is so named because of its spider-like plants, or spiderettes, which dangle down from the mother plant like spiders on a web. Available in green or variegated varieties, these spiderettes often start out as small white flowers. Spider Plant is also a champion cleanser of air. The NASA tests showed it to remove around 90% of the harmful chemical formaldehyde from the air. Since formaldehyde is found in common household products like adhesives, grout and fillers, it's a good idea to keep one of these plants around your kitchen and bathrooms especially.

Common name(s): Spider plant, Chlorophytum comosum, Ribbon Plant, airplane plant.

Flower colours: Greenish-white, white.

Bloom time: Rarely bloom.

Max reachable height: Up to 60 centimeters.

Difficulty to grow: Easy to grow.

Planting and care

Initial care for 1-2 weeks after receiving plant at your location:

Keep the plant in natural indirect bright light.
Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
Water when top soil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch.
Do not re-pot for min. 2 weeks after receiving it.

Key requirements to keep plant healthy:

Sunlight: natural bright light/indirect bright light.

Soil: Soil should be well drain and fertile, rich in organic content.

Water: Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture. Water when topsoil (1-2 inches) feels dry to touch. Water thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.

Temperature: 18-32 degrees Celcius.

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer.

Caring for Chlorophytum

Sunlight

- Keep the plant indoor with natural bright light/indirect bright light.
- **Soil**ect the plant from direct harsh sunlight as it can cause damage to the foliage.
- **Watering** should be well drained and fertile rich in oragnic content.
- Poke your finger/plain small stick into the soil to check the moisture.
- Water when top soil (3-4 inches) feels dry to touch.
- **Application of Fertilizer** summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.
- During the main growing season feed the plant with organic fertilizer once a month.
- **Repotting** topsoil without disturbing the roots of the plant so it can uptake the nutrients and moisture easily.
- When a plant outgrows in current pot, re-pot with fresh potting soil and some fertilizer.
- **On the repotting procedure** [link](#) to keep the plant in shady area for 2 to 3 days and then move the plant in its suitable climatic condition.

Plant Protection

- Remove dead, infected or damaged plant parts and dispose them away from the planting area.
 - Spray Neem, Eucalyptus or Citrus oil for any insect/pest attack, as a primary treatment.
- Don'ts**
- Easily grows in AC rooms but away from AC vents.
 - Do not over-water the plant especially when pot does not have drainage holes.

Typical uses of Chlorophytum

Special features: Excellent air purifier plant according to NASA

Ornamental use: Best as potted plant and in hanging basket.
