Description for Acacia Mearnsii, Black Wattle

Acacia mearnsii is a fast-growing, extremely invasive leguminous tree native to Australia. Common names for it include black wattle, Acacia-negra, Australian acacia, Australische Akazie, Swartwattel, Uwatela.

Planting and care

The deep planting encourages the developing stem to send out roots to help stabilize the plant and perhaps eliminate the need for staking. Also, deep planting keeps lily bulbs cool when temperatures soar.

Partial Shade	Well-drained soil	Medium	21 to 30 degrees C	Apply any organic fertilizer

Caring for Acacia Mearnsii

- Apply a high-potassium liquid fertilizer every 2 weeks from early spring until 6 weeks after flowering.
- Keep moist in winter.
