The deep planting encourages the developing stem to send out roots to help stabilize the plant and perhaps eliminate the need for staking. Also, deep planting keeps lily bulbs cool when temperatures soar.

Sunlight: Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: 21-30 °C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Apply a high-potassium liquid fertilizer every 2 weeks from early spring until 6 weeks after flowering.
- Keep moist in winter.

Special Feature:

It can be used for mass planting in shady locations.

Ornamental use:

- The plant is used for ornamental purpose.

Note:

Bacterial and fungal spots, powdery mildew, bacterial wilt. Minimize wetting of foliage to avoid disease.
