Planting & Care

Germinate in vitro in gelatin, agar or other medium.

Sunlight: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Soil: Plant in sandy, well-drained soil.

Water: Normal, Can tolerate more.

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer.

Care:

- It grows best in warm and humid climate and rich loamy soil.
- The growth is rapid in the first 6-8 years and the tree attains maximum size in about 20 years.
- Flowers appear from June to August.
- Tree comes to flowering when 4-5 years old.
- Planted near houses and roadsides as a shade tree.

- One of the most frequently planted tree in the tropics.

Harvesting: Allow unblemished fruit to ripen; clean and dry seeds. Properly cleaned, seed can be successfully stored.

Care:

- Kadamba leaves may develop yellowing due to iron deficiency in very alkaline poorly drained soils.

Special Feature:

It's said that this tree blossoms with these flowers at the sound of monsoon thunder.

- Used in treating diabetes.

Ornamental use:

- The plant is used for ornamental purpose.
