Commonly mistaken for cacti or aloe plants, Agave is a separate genus with very distinct features. Native to the southwestern United States and Mexico, there are over 200 species of Agave plants.

Common name(s): Agave species

Flower colours: Light grayish green to yellow.

Max reachable height: Up to 2 feet.

Planting and care

In partially shaded areas, this plant can be used as a focal point in a desert garden, or in groups as a barrier. The saw-like flat leaves grow from a dense rosette base and spiral outwards.

Sunlight: Full Sun

Soil: Well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: 20 to 35 degree C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Caring for Agave Lophantha

- These plants are susceptible to root rot due to overwatering, so water carefully—too much moisture will kill them.
- Only water when the soil completely dries out.
- They require well-draining soil and prefer a sandy cactus soil mix.

Typical uses of Agave Lophantha

Special features: The leaves are used to season meat and other foods in Caribbean, Latin American and Asian cuisines. It is often added to chutneys, a sauce containing fruits or vegetables that is eaten with other dishes.

Culinary use: NA

Ornamental use: The plant is used for ornamental purpose.

Medicinal use: Used externally, it is very effective on burns and sunburn, as well as a variety of skin diseases (eczema, pruritus, psoriasis, acne) it is extremely constructive and protective.
