Description Acalypha is a genus of flowering plants in the family Euphorbiaceae. It is the sole genus of the subtribe Acalyphinae. It is one of the largest euphorb genera, with approximately 450 to 462 species.

Bloom time: Flowers freely

Planting & Care

Acalypha growing shrub? or small tree of the genus Acalypha also known as Copperleaf, Acalypha perennial evergreen or annual plant also used as ornamental hedge plant or indoor plant, can grow in tropic mediterranean, subtropical or temperate climate

Sunlight: Full sun to part shade

Soil: Clay Soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: 10 °C.

Fertilizer: apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Put the pot or container in a sunny or partially shaded location if growing it outdoors, or near a window with bright light inside.
- Finally, in the care of Acalypha wilkesiana, always apply some water after planting.

Special Feature:

Garden Uses: In St. Louis, grow in containers or baskets on decks, patios or rooftop gardens. It is a good plant for color and should be used as an accent for both color and texture in a container. Or, it can be grown year-round in a greenhouse or sun room giving the area a tropical feel. Use
