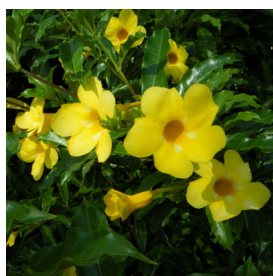


## Allamanda Creeper (Yellow) - Plant

### Description for Allamanda Creeper (Yellow)

As shrub Allamanda grows very thick and get covered with yellow bell shaped 3 to 4 inches long blooms in growing season. Although it dose not have tendrils to climb but provided support can grow as vine too.

### Planting and care

Allamanda is a bushy nature plant, large sized container is preferable as the plant gets heavy with the time. You may need to repot it every year. Regardless of size , make sure container has drainage holes at bottom to ensure smooth drainage of water. Put stone or brick pieces on the holes.

Sunlight	Soil	Water	Temperature	Fertilizer
Full sun to Partial shade.	Any good-quality potting mix.	Water thoroughly, then allow the top 2 inches (5 cm) of soil to dry out between waterings. Empty drainage tray to prevent soggy soil.	Average to warm temperatures 65-80°F/18-27°C. Allamanda plant is frost-tender. Actually, it doesn't like the cold at all. It will tolerate a minimum of 60°F/16°C in winter.	Feed every 2 weeks spring through fall with a high-phosphorus liquid fertilizer diluted by half.

### Caring for Allamanda Creeper

- Allamanda grows very rapidly and needs pruning due to its bushy nature.
- Also pruning increases air circulation in plant required for good growth.

### Typical uses of Allamanda Creeper

**Special features:** The bell-shaped allamanda flower is very fragrant, yellow and appearing in summer can reach 4-5 inches across. Flowers can last until late November and into December.

**Ornamental use:** Allamandas are popularly used as ornamental plants. They can be grown in sheltered areas as well as indoors with care as potted plants.
