Description for Amaranthus tricolour mixed

Amaranthus tricolor mixed is a very usefully as a temporary shrub. Attractive bright foliage plant blooms in after spring has faded. It goes by common names such as love-lies-bleeding, pendant amaranth, tassel flower, velvet flower, foxtail amaranth, and Quilete.

Planting and care

Plant where they will receive a minimum of 5 to 6 hours of full sun per day. Plants grown in weak sun may not die at once, but they weaken gradually. Give them plenty of organic matter when planting and don't crowd them. Wear sturdy gloves to protect your hands from prickly thorns.

Sunlight: Full sun to part shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: 20 to 30 degrees C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Caring for Amaranthus tricolour mixed

- Every leaf has a growth bud, so removing old flower blossoms encourages the plant to make more foliage instead of using the energy to make seeds.
- Clean away from around the base of the rosebushes any trimmed debris that can harbor disease and insects.
- Watering should be done early in the morning when the soil is dry.

Harvesting

July to frost

Typical uses of Amaranthus tricolour mixed

Special features: May be used in beds or borders. Interesting edging along walks or paths.

Ornamental use: Amaranthus plant use as an ornamental plant or indoor plant.
