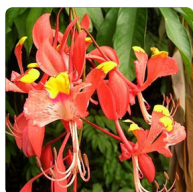


Amherstia nobilis - Plant

Description Amherstia nobilis is native to tropical forests of Myanmar (Burma) from where it has been collected for cultivation. These colorful flowers appear on drooping branches and create a spectacular show when in full bloom. This is the time when it attracts birds, butterflies and by-passers.

Common name: Pride of Burma and sometimes Queen of Flowering Trees.

Color: Crimson red.

Bloom time: between February and May.

Height: 30 -40

Difficulty level: Easy.

Sunlight: Full to partial sun

Soil: Fertile soil with a neutral pH.

Water: Keep the soil moist, do not overwater.

Temperature: Night temperature not below than 55 degree C.

Fertilizer: Use organic mulch to enrich the soil.
