Description Andrographis paniculata is an annual herbaceous plant in the family Acanthaceae, native to India and Sri Lanka. It is widely cultivated in Southern and Southeastern Asia, where it has been traditionally used to treat infections and some diseases. Mostly the leaves and roots were used for medicinal purposes. The whole plant is also used in some cases.

Common name: Andrographis paniculata

Color: rose coloured

Bloom time: November - December.

Height: 30-. 110 cm

Difficulty level: easy to grow

Planting & Care

The deep planting encourages the developing stem to send out roots to help stabilize the plant and perhaps eliminate the need for staking. Also, deep planting keeps lily bulbs cool when temperatures soar.

Sunlight: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: 200 °C, 180 °C,

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Growing plants can be inexpensive, particularly when growing them from seed.

- Seeds of plants flowers should usually be sown directly into the sunny flower bed, as developing roots do not like to be disturbed.

Care:

- Deadhead to prolong flowering.
- Maintain moderate soil moisture and fertilize lightly.
- plant will die with the first frost.

Special Feature:

The leaves are used to season meat and other foods in Caribbean, Latin American and Asian cuisines. It is often added to chutneys, a sauce containing fruits or vegetables that is eaten with other dishes.

Use

Medicinal use:

- Since ancient times, Kariyat is used as a wonder drug in traditional Siddha and Ayurvedic systems of medicine as well as in tribal medicine in India and some other countries for multiple clinical applications.
- The therapeutic value of Kalmegh is due to its mechanism of action which is perhaps by enzyme induction.
- The plant extract exhibits antityphoid and antifungal activities.

- The plant is used for ornamental purpose.
