Description

### Description for Antirrhinum Dwarf Mixed

Snapdragons are a particular favorite of children who like to pinch the tiny individual blossoms and make the "dragon mouth" open and close. Their large, blossom-laden flower heads are faintly fragrant and come in in a wide assortment of bright colors.

The vertical flower spikes, opening gradually from the bottom to the top, are available in two heights: dwarf varieties grow to about 10 inches while the taller types grow to a height of 18-24 inches.

A variety that grows up to 5 feet has been developed, but it must be staked. A single snapdragon plant may produce seven or eight blossom spikes in the course of a summer.

**Common name(s):** snapdragons or dragon flowers.

**Flower colours:** Snapdragon flowers come in many varieties, including dwarf (8 inches tall) to tall ones (3 feet) and in an array of colors, including pastel colors, reds, pinks, yellows and even bicolored flowers. These beautiful flowers can be cut and displayed indoors.

**Bloom time:** late spring

**Max reachable height:** Up to 12 to 13 inches.

**Difficulty to grow::** Easy

## Planting and care

May be grown from cuttings or from seed. If planting from seed, sow indoors on the surface of the soil for 8 weeks before last frost (see Starting Annual Flowers Indoors). Seeds will germinate in 10-20 days. For best results, sow in vermiculite and water from below. Plant outdoors after last frost.

Pinch back young plants after 4-6 leaves have appeared to encourage a bushy habit and apply an organic flower fertilizer for optimum plant health. Spent flowers should be picked often to encourage more blooms. If blooms become scarce, cut back plants drastically then feed and water generously. Plants may need to be staked when young.

**Sunlight:** Full sun.

**Soil:** Snapdragons like a neutral soil pH.  
Snapdragons best in sunny locations with rich, well-drained soil

**Water:** Provide approximately an inch of water per week in times of no rainfall.

**Temperature:** cool temperature

**Fertilizer:** Fertilize snapdragon flowers once a month with an all-purpose fertilizer.

## Caring for Antirrhinum Dwarf Mixed

- May be grown from cuttings or from seed. If planting from seed, sow indoors on the surface of the soil for 8 weeks before last frost (see Starting Annual Flowers Indoors).
- Seeds will germinate in 10-20 days. For best results, sow in vermiculite and water from below.

## Harvesting

80 to 100 days from seeds to flower

## Typical uses of Antirrhinum Dwarf Mixed

### Special features:

Plants will not flourish where temperatures are high for long periods of time. Blooms will tolerate some frost. Under favorable conditions, snapdragons will self-sow in the garden.

**Ornamental use:** Used for decorations.
