Description

Description for Arisaema speciosum, Cobra Lily (Purple)

The spathe is up to 20 cm long, dark black-purple and longitudinally striped towards the base with white, with a broadly lance-shaped curved

blade narrowed to the tip. Spadix appendage is dark purple, thickened curved and white at the base, and with a very long thread-like tail.

Common name(s): Grand Cobra Lily, Himalayan Giant Cobra Lily, Double-Whip Cobra Lily

Flower colours: Dark Purple/Black

Bloom time: Mid Spring, Late Spring/Early Summer

Max reachable height: Up to 24 inches

Difficulty to grow: Easy to grow

Planting and care

Grand Cobra Lily is native to the Eastern Himalayan region. Plant *Arisaema* tubers 4-6 inches deep.

Sunlight: Light Shade

Soil: Moist but not wet, with good drainage

Water: Medium

Temperature: 16 to 25 degrees C

Fertilizer: Incorporate leaf mold, compost, and perlite

Caring for *Arisaema speciosum*

- Water regularly; do not overwater.
- Requires consistently moist soil; do not let dry out between 2 waterings.
- The north or east side of a building, that protects them from all day sun.
- *Arisaema* must be kept quite dry during their winter dormancy

Harvesting

Typical uses of *Arisaema speciosum*

Special features: Distinctly stalked unequal elliptic leaflets up to a foot long, with red margins

Ornamental use: The plant is used as an ornamental plant.
