### Description for Aristolochia reticulata

Aristolochia reticulata is a PERENNIAL growing to 0.4 m (1ft 4in). It is in flower from May to July. The flowers are hermaphrodite (have both male and female organs) and are pollinated by Flies. Suitable for: medium (loamy) soils and prefers well-drained soil. Suitable pH: acid, neutral and basic (alkaline) soils. It can grow in semi-shade (light woodland) or no shade. It prefers moist soil.

### Planting and care

Prefers a well-drained loamy soil, rich in organic matter, in sun or semi-shade. Succeeds in ordinary garden soil

### Caring for Aristolochia reticulata

Prune / thin out every 1-3 years.

### Typical uses of Aristolochia reticulata

**Special features:** one frequently sees Dutchman s pipe vines growing up the front of a porch on older homes, in which role they cast welcome shade during summer s scorching reign (while simultaneously furnishing some privacy).

**Ornamental use:** used for ornamental purpose.

**Medicinal use:** The root is aromatic, bitter, diaphoretic, stimulant and stomachic. The dried rhizome of Aristolochia reticulata is sometimes sold as serperntary for the treatment of snakebites. It is used as a tonic to calm the stomach, promote urination, and increase perspiration.
