### Planting & Care

**Sunlight:** Full sun

### Care:

- Living trees are happiest with cool temperatures and bright, outdoor light.
- Bring your tree indoors for no longer than 10 day stretches and choose a sunny spot away from any heat vents.
- You can also place your tree outside your doorstep for a few days to give it a break from the heat and limited light indoors.

### Special Feature:

Attractive pine for the landscape. Specimen or small groups. Also may be grown as a screen or windbreak.

Use

**Ornamental use:**

- The plant is used for ornamental purpose.
- Its generally kep indoor in living room and in terrac area.
- 

**Note:**

In its native habitat, healthy, well-maintained trees usually have few major problems. This pine can be difficult to grow well in the St. Louis area because of soil and climate. It is susceptible to tip blight, rusts and rots.
