Description Arctium is a genus of biennial plants commonly known as burdock, family Asteraceae. Native to the Old World, several species have been widely introduced worldwide.

Common name: Monarda fistulosa

Color: dark brown

Bloom time: July to September

Height: 2.00 to 4.00 feet

Difficulty level: easy to grow

Planting & Care

Burdock is easy to grow. It grows readily in the wild, without day human assistance. The attention you provide to it in your garden, will promote bigger, deeper roots, and more plant and seed to harvest. Burdock likes full sun, but will tolerate partial shade.

Sunlight: Full sun to part shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Dry to medium

Temperature: 40°C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Seeds can direct sown outdoors in the fall once the last frost has passed, or started earlier indoors for improved germination rates and stability for young plants.

Special Feature:

Provides color and contrast for the herb garden, wild garden, native plant garden, meadow or naturalized area.

Ornamental use:

Note:

Powdery mildew can be a significant problem with the monardas, particularly in crowded gardens with poor air circulation. This species has good mildew resistance, however. Rust can also be a problem.
