Description Easily grown in average, dry to medium, well-drained soils in full sun. Prefers dryish, sandy soils. Self-seeds in optimum growing conditions. Plants tend to open up and sprawl if grown in overly fertile soils or in anything less than full sun.

**Common name:** Gayfeather, Blazing Star, Button Snakeroot

**Bloom time:** June to September

**Planting & Care**

Liatris are hardy perennials that reach between 60 cm to 1.8 m in height. They flower from the summer until the early months of autumn. The flower stems of Liatris carry purple or white flowers. These plants are useful for growing in the garden borders.

**Sunlight:** Full sun

**Soil:** well-drained soil

**Water:** Dry to medium

**Temperature:** ± 18°C

**Fertilizer:** Apply any organic fertilizer

**Care:**

- Belonging to the Liatris genus (Liatris spicata Button snakeroot ), Button snakeroot is a variety of Prairie Gayfeather.
- Button snakeroot is a heirloom variety.
- Normally grows to a mature height of 1.50 metres (4.88 feet).

No serious insect or disease problems. Taller plants may need support, however staking of these substantial plants in a cosmetically acceptable manner can be difficult. Massing plants in naturalized areas where they can provide some support to each other may be the best solution for this problem.
