Planting and care

plant care may require a bit of effort, but the results are well worth the work. Not all plants are fragrant, but the most common and hardy do produce a sweet, carrying fragrance. Common is a vine and has larger glossy green leaves than Royal. Both can survive in temperate climates if they are planted in a sheltered area.

Caring for Cailendra

Plants love water but don't drown them. That is, they don't like to sit in water, and they will die if the soil is too wet in winter. The ideal soil is rich and loose, with good drainage. One of the worst mistakes you can make is to not provide adequate drainage.

Special features: Butterfly gardens, meadows, prairies, or naturalized/native plant areas. Borders.

Ornamental use: The plant is used for ornamental purpose.
