Description Winter hardy to USDA Zones 10-11. In the St. Louis area, grown in pots or containers. Prefers light, organically rich, medium moisture, well-drained soils in part shade. Tolerates bright full shade.

**Common name:** firecracker flower

**Color:** Apricot to salmon pink

**Bloom time:** Flowers freely

**Height:** 1.00 to 3.00 feet

**Difficulty level:** easy to grow

### Planting & Care

Propagating Firecracker Plants and Growing them from Seed. Firecracker Flower plants are easily propagated with 3"-4" stem cuttings taken early in the spring. Crossandra seeds require light for germination, so don't cover them! Sow seeds indoors during any season.

**Sunlight:** Full Sun to Partial Shade

**Soil:** well-drained soil

**Water:** Medium

**Temperature:** 75° with cooler, 60°-65° nights

**Fertilizer:** Apply any organic fertilizer

**Care:**

- Firecracker Flower plants are easily propagated with 3"-4" stem cuttings taken early in the spring.
- Crossandra seeds require light for germination, so don't cover them! Sow seeds indoors during any season.
- Maintain a temperature in the growing medium of 75°-80° until germination, which takes 25-30 days.
